## Story Time and Daily News

Is designed to develop pre-reading skills, letter and initial sound re cognition, number and number value recognition and Calendar Skills and Weather Awareness. To help the children develop an awareness of the environment and time passage. To develop and improve listening skills, speaking and communication skills and attention span. Most importantly we hope to develop in our students a deep respect for the rights of other children as well as their own rights and responsibilities.

#### Snack Time

To provide refreshment, rest and reinforce socially acceptable table manners. Parents will receive a monthly calendar indicating your child's snack day. Each child will be given the opportunity to bring in a snack for the class and be the leader for the day.

#### Arts and Crafts

To promote creative expression, fine motor skills, eye/hand coordination and prewriting skills.
